## SUSEET

SUSEET is a Summer School in European Environmental Taxation that will take place online from 21st to 26th June 2021 with the support of the **European Union.** 

It is a course where undergraduate students who are achieving their degree in law or economics or postgraduate students (master or Ph.D.) will learn the fundamentals of European environmental taxation, gaining an awareness of the complex economic and social issues related to this topic. SUSEET has been designed to provide participants with suitable expertise on environmental taxation, useful both for the construction of an academic career and for a professional one, contributing to the creation of a new generation of European environmental tax lawyers and economists. It will provide the occasion for participants from all over the world to interact with eminent professors and experts working in this field.

This year SUSEET has been included in the program "All4Climate Italy 2021" in preparation for the pre-COP26 ministerial meeting and the international event dedicated to young people "Youth4Climate 2021: Driving Ambition" which will take place from 28th September to 2nd October in Milan.

## LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

**To provide** a comprehensive view on the economic and legal basis of environmental taxation;

**To explore** the European constraints to the introduction of fiscal instruments to protect the environment: State Aid rules, freedom of movement, prohibition of discrimination, etc.;

**To illustrate** the multiple interactions between tax and environment in terms of global policies and their economic and social effects;

**To demonstrate** the challenges and new opportunities provided by the circular economy;

**To analyse** energy taxation principles and their concrete application in the framework of the EU energy transition strategy;

**To discuss** the European Green Deal and fiscal mechanisms to support a green and inclusive tax reform.
